3. Late summer yearling heifer, calved between July 1 and Aug. 31, 2008
4. Summer yearling heifer, calved between May 1 and June 30, 2008
5. Late junior yearling heifer, calved between Mar. 1 and Apr. 30, 2008
6. Early junior yearling heifer, calved between Jan. 1 and Feb. 28, 2008
7. Senior yearling heifer, calved between Aug. 1 and Dec. 31, 2007
8. Female over 2 years, born Aug. 1, 2007; has calved or been certified with calf
 - a. Senior Champion (first place winners from lots 7 & 8. ribbon only)
 - b. Reserve Senior Champion (second place winner in champion lot is eligible to show for Reserve Senior Champion. ribbon only)
9. Two females (bred and owned by exhibitor)
10. Female with offspring calved Jan. 1, 2009 or after

CHAMPION BULL CLASSES:

11. Junior bull calf, calved after Jan. 1, 2009
12. Senior bull calf, calved between Sept. 1 and Dec. 31, 2008
 - a. Calf Champion (first place winners from lot 1 & 2. ribbon only)
 - b. Reserve Calf Champion (second place winner in champion lot is eligible to show for

13. Summer yearling bull, calved between May 1 and Aug. 31, 2008
 14. Late junior yearling bull, calved between Jan. 1 and Apr. 30, 2008
 - a. Junior Champion (first place winners from lots 13 & 14. ribbon only)
 - b. Reserve Junior Champion (second place winner in champion lot is eligible to show for Reserve Junior Champion. ribbon only)
 15. Senior yearling and 2 year old Jan. 1 through Dec. 31, 2007
 16. Bull calved before Jan. 1 2007
 - a. Senior Champion (first place winner in lots 15 & 16. ribbon only)
 - b. Reserve Senior Champion (second place winner in champion lot is eligible to show for Reserve Senior Champion. ribbon only)
 17. Two bulls bred and owned by exhibitor
 18. Junior Get of Sire. Three animals, both sexes represented, sired by one bull, all owned by exhibitor.
 19. Best Four Head, all owned by exhibitor.
