GENERAL INFORMATION

- Pre-registration due by July 14, 2009
- Dairy will show on Wednesday, July 15th, after the 4H Dairy Show.
- Exhibitor must show at least three animals to be eligible for Herdsmanship Awards. All exhibits will be inspected and scored daily.
- Entry fee: \$5.00 per head, no entry fee for group classes

CLASS:

1. Bull calf born between Aug. 31, 2008 and May 31, 2009
2. Bull yearling born between July 1, 2007 and June 30, 2008
 - a. Champion bull (first place winners from lots 1 & 2. ribbon only)
3. Junior calf born after Mar. 1, 2009, at least 4 months old
4. Intermediate calf born between Dec. 1, 2008 and Feb. 2, 2009
5. Senior calf born between Sept. 1 and Nov. 30, 2008
6. Summer yearling born between June 1 and Aug. 31, 2008
7. Junior yearling born between Mar. 1 and May 31, 2008
8. Senior yearling born between Sept. 1, 2007 and Feb. 28, 2008
 - a. Junior Champion Female (first place winners from lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8. ribbon only)
9. Female 2 years and under 3, born between July 1, 2006 and June 30, 2007
10. Female 3 years and under 4, born between July 1, 2005 and June 30, 2006
11. Female 4 years and under 5, born between July 1, 2004 and June 30, 2005
12. Female 5 years and over, prior to July 1, 2003
 - a. Senior Champion Female (first place winners from lots 10, 11, 12 & 13. ribbon only)

- b. Grand Champion Female
- c. Reserve Champion Female
- 13. Dairy Herd - Four cows all freshened, owned by exhibitor. One entry per exhibitor
- 14. Junior Get of Sire - Four animals under 2 years, either sex
- 15. Get of Sire - Four animals, one to be at least 2 years old; no more than 2 bulls. One entry per exhibitor
- 16. Produce of Dam - Two animals any age, any sex. One entry per exhibitor
