All Livestock is required to go through Vet Check prior to entering the grounds. Vet Check hours are on Sunday, July 12th from 9am to 12noon and from 3pm to 5pm. All Livestock must be in place by 6pm on Sunday. Please see health regulations on Exhibitor Info page. They will be strictly adhered to.

NOTICE: 4-H'ers may cross over their 4-H animals to Open Class. Open Class rules & regulations apply. All crossovers must notify the Open Class Superintendent by July 9, 2009 to qualify for Open Class Entry.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Check in time is Sunday, July 12, 2009, 9am to Noon and 3pm to 5pm.
- Dusting of rabbits or cavies on the Event Complex property will not be permitted.
- The A.R.B.A. Standard of Perfection will be the guide in awarding the prizes on all varieties recognized therein.
- The exhibitor or representative must be present to bring the animal to the show table. Animals not presented on the table after two calls will not be judged.
- Animals shall remain on display through end of Fair.
- The Exhibitor must care for their own Open Class Rabbits and Cavies and provide their own feed.
- Exhibitors with young or baby rabbits or cavies must provide escape proof cages. Please contact the superintendent.
- Rabbits under 6 weeks old will not be allowed in the barn. No pregnant rabbits. Please contact the Superintendent if you are entering a doe and litter class.
- All rabbits and cavies must be tattooed or tagged for identification. If you have any questions, contact the Superintendent.
- Entry fees for rabbits and cavies entered but not shown will be forfeited.
- No distinguishing marks will be permitted on cages until after the judging is complete and the Superintendent has posted awards.
- All rabbits and cavies will be judged by breed except cross-breeds, those will be judged on the condition of the animal.
- There must be three exhibits in each breed to qualify for Best of Breed categories, and three exhibits in each class to qualify for Best of Class.
- No selling of rabbits or cavies will be allowed during the fair -absolutely no "for sale" signs allowed.
- Absolutely no carriers allowed in barn prior to check out time.
- NO ENTRY CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER JULY 12, 2009.
- Entry Fee - \$1.00 per Class entered. Fee must accompany entry form.
- Pre-Kindergarten and 4-H Adventurers may decorate their animal's cage.
