GENERAL INFORMATION

- Open Class Show Saturday, July 18 2009 at 9am
- September 1st will be used as the base date for computing ages of sheep in all classes. Only those animals that have lambs teeth will be eligible to show in lamb classes.
- All animals showing in group classes must also show as individuals. Group entries must be made at the same time as individual entries.
- Entry Fee: \$2 per head, \$0.50 fleece shorn in 2009

1. Yearling Ram: One year and under two. Sept. 1, 2007 to Aug. 31, 2007
2. Junior Ram Lamb: Feb. 1, 2008 to June 6, 2008
3. Senior Ram Lamb: Sept. 1, 2008 to Jan. 31, 2009
4. Pair Ram Lamb: Bred and owned by exhibitor
5. Yearling Ewe: One year and under two. Sept. 1, 2007 to Aug. 31, 2008
6. Pair Yearling Ewes: Bred and owned by exhibitor
7. Senior Ewe Lamb: Sept. 1, 2008 to Jan. 31, 2009
8. Junior Ewe Lamb: Feb. 1, 2009 to June 1, 2009
9. Pair Ewe Lambs: Bred and owned by exhibitor
10. Young Flock: One ram lamb & two ewe lambs. Bred and owned by exhibitor
11. Get of Sire: Four animals under two years of age, both sexes represented, all by the same sire. Bred and owned by exhibitor
12. Flock: One ram under two years, two yearling ewes and two ewe lambs owned by exhibitor
13. Best Pair: Both sexes represented. Bred and owned by exhibitor
14. Fleece: above breed list

SHEEP AWARDS

- **Columbia County Fair Board** will sponsor one high point trophy to be awarded at the Judge's discretion.
- **Rosettes** will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion Ewe and Ram of each breed
- **Ribbons** to 3rd place – if there are 4 to 6 exhibitors in the class
