GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entries will be accepted only on Sunday, July 12th from 11am to 3pm and on Monday, July 13, 2009 from 12noon to 8pm.
- Entries will be released after 5:30pm on Sunday, July 19th, 2009.
- Entries must have been completed within the last 3 years of entry and must not have been previously exhibited at this fair.
- Entries are limited to 24" x 36" plus frame. All art work must be dry.
- **The Columbia County Fair is not responsible for any exhibits broken or damaged during the fair.**
- Drawings without hanging device will be stapled or taped to the display.
- Framed entries without proper hanging device will not be accepted.
- No more than 6 entries per exhibitor and no more than 2 entries in each class.
- Since the fair is family oriented, all entries must be in good taste. Nudes will not be accepted.
- All awards given at the judge's discretion. The judges will remain anonymous.
