- Entries will be released after 5:30pm on Sunday, July 19th, 2009.
- Any leisure time activity that is of general interest and worthy of recommendation to the "other" category may be entered as a hobby.
- Entries are limited to two entries per class per exhibitor.
- Entries must be the handiwork of the exhibitor where applicable, and representative of the hobby of the exhibitor.
- Articles exhibited in the Hobby Department in previous Columbia County Fairs **will not** be accepted.
- Collections should be suitably mounted for proper display where applicable. The Fair reserves the right to limit the size of all exhibits due to availability of spacing

HOBBY & CRAFT SPECIAL AWARDS

- **Columbia County Fair Board** will sponsor two high point trophies to be awarded at the Judge's discretion, one for hobby and one for craft.
- **Pat Olson, NW Mortgage Group, Inc.** will sponsor a \$15.00 cash award to be given at the Superintendent's discretion
- **Green & Groovy Award – Hobby & Craft**
 - Following the concept of Reduce, Reuse & Recycle exhibits must be accompanied by a 3X5 card that explains how the exhibit:
 - Reduces energy consumption, preserves natural resources or saves money
 - Can be used for multiple purposes
 - Is made from recycled items
 - List items used and what they were previously used for
 - Exhibit will most likely incorporate several concepts. Each exhibit must be presented in a neat and clean manner. The award will be given at the Superintendents discretion.
 - Examples: Melting down old crayons and making a candle, using recycled items to make a checkers game, a doll made from other items previously used for something else. The award will be given at the Superintendents discretion.
